### BWA opening for more year groups – update

As you know, we have been asked to consider how we **COVID-19 UPDATE** can safely open to more pupils on 1<sup>st</sup> June. There is a stream of guidance being sent to schools daily. We continue to work relentlessly to establish how we can

open safely for more pupils, should the 5 key tests be met. It is really important to remember that BWA has never been closed. This has been an extraordinary time for all school staff and I am immensely proud of how quickly they have adapted.

School will no doubt be a very different place for some time to come. The measures we have been asked to consider currently to reduce risk include:

- children being taught in groups of no more than 15
- no mixing of the groups (and the staff teaching/supporting them) throughout the whole day and subsequent days
- only one adult to accompany the children to school and to avoid using public transport
- staggered school start and end times to reduce contact and mixing
- limit movement in classrooms and resources

This potentially means that not all pupils will be taught by their class teacher, in their usual room or with all of their classmates.

The government believe demand will be low, so it was interesting to know what you are considering. We know keeping your child and your family are your top priority and wouldn't compromise on this.

Please ensure calls between pupils and teachers this week are not impacted too much by your enquiries about what the plans are to open BWA to more pupils. Please be assured I will continue to communicate with you on any developments that are important to share.
