Snowflakes in 3B

The children in 3B had a fantastic time following verbal instructions and working on their fine motor skills in their art lesson in order to create some gorgeous snowflakes. They were very excited to take their final products home for the Christmas holidays.

Step One:

Fold a piece of A3 along a diagonal to make a square and cut off the edge.



Step Two:

With the paper still folded into a triangle, draw lines from the folded side toward the tip – make sure you don't go all the way.



Step Three:

Cut along the lines.




Step Four:

Open up the paper. Fold over the centre bit and glue together.



Step Five

Turn the snowflake over and glue the next bit of paper closest to the centre. Repeat until all are glued to create a petal.





Step Six:

Glue 6 completed petals together in the centre and on one end.
