Nursery	<p><u>Musical Discovery</u> Children will learn short songs, and practise their ability to imitate sounds in a Call & Echo fashion; singing back melodies and clapping back rhythms. Year Two	<p><u>Singing Games / The Weather</u> Children will develop their Singing Confidence, Pitch-Matching and sense of Pulse/Rhythm through short songs and games. They will explore concepts related to The Weather around the World through a variety of songs, and learn to create sounds that imitate Weather vocally and through Percussion instruments .</p>	<p><u>Musical Storyland</u> Children will spend this time learning about music through various stories, expanding their ability to make musical choices when composing and learning new storytelling musical repertoire.</p>	<p><u>The Vocal Project</u> The children of Reception, Year 1 and 2 will learn repertoire, simultaneously to children of those year groups in other Wandsworth Primary schools. Year Four	<p><u>The Vocal Project</u> The children of Year 3 and 4 will learn repertoire, simultaneously to children of those year groups in other Wandsworth Primary schools. The repertoire focuses developing singing in Parts, and Wandsworth Music offer the opportunity for a mass performance involving all schools at the end of the term.</p>	<p><u>Jazz Music</u> Children will develop their Vocal Ensemble skills, and their grasp of harder rhythmic concepts, whilst learning about the language and culture of Jazz music.</p>	<p><u>Classical Music / Glockenspiels</u> Children will develop their ability to read and play notation on Glockenspiels through the lens of Classical music, engaging with classic repertoire and more challenging melodies.</p>
Year Five	<p><u>Folk Music</u> Children will learn a variety of Folk Music from around the World, focusing on Ensemble Singing and more advanced Rhythmic Concepts on Percussion instruments. Their music learning in this term will deepen their understanding of World Geography and other cultures.</p>	<p><u>The Vocal Project</u> The children of Year 5 and 6 will learn repertoire, simultaneously to children of those year groups in other Wandsworth Primary schools. Year Six
