# Re: Arrangements for 2021-22

The tables below set out the start and end of day arrangements for next year. We have liaised with EdW to ensure the pupils in the three streams have a calm start to the school day. The arrangements are quite similar to this year. Pupils will wash their hands before entering their classroom, you will notice that adults are expected to wear a mask in the line or whilst onsite and we ask that families socially distance when in the line. We hope this helps the school community feel safe at these times. Should these arrangements need to be amended we will let you know before the first day of term.

# **Late Pupils**

The same arrangement will remain be in place. Pupils who miss their entry time must wait by the side if the gate is still open until a member of staff indicates it is safe for them to enter. There should be no queue jumping. Once the gate is closed, all pupils who are late must be taken be accompanied by an adult to the school office via the pedestrian gate. The adult must and wait with the pupil until a member of staff comes out to collect the pupil.

## **Family Friendly Arrangements**

If you have children in more than one year group, siblings can enter at the earliest slot together, from 8:30am only. Siblings of nursery pupils cannot start before 8:30am. Nursery pupils may enter school with their older siblings.

I encourage families to speak to me about alternate start times due to other family commitments in the morning. We are here to help so please do talk through anything we can do to ease the pressure of the morning school run.

#### **Medicines**

If your child requires medication at school please bring it to school on the first day of the year or when the need arises. Please remember that you should complete this online form before bringing the medication to school.

### **Term Dates**

The ESFA have confirmed that the 2021-22 school year will be reduced to 378 pupil teaching sessions (i.e. 189 days) to take account of the additional bank holiday. As a result the school year for the English stream will finish a day early on Thursday 21 July 2022 (rather than Friday 22 July 2022). Thank you in advance for your understanding. We will make this amendment on the school website but wanted you to be aware as soon as possible.

The first day of term is Monday 6<sup>th</sup> September. We ask that families travelling abroad fulfil the requirements to quarantine on their return to the UK as they stand at the time and inform us if they are unable to be in school.

### Uniform

The <u>school uniform expectations</u> are set out on the website. If buying new uniform, the simple expectation is that clothing and accessories should be school colours (blue, red, white) only. Please also keep in mind that

- Shoes should be worn to school, not trainers.
- School PE kit will be worn on uniform days.
- Hair accessories should be school colours.
- Hats worn should be school ones or school colours with no other logos.
